RESURRECTION WEEK 3: The Gospel of John Account

Monday April 15 John 21:1-9

21 After this, Jesus appeared to his disciples again. It was by the Sea of Galilee. Here is what happened. 2 Simon Peter and Thomas, who was also called Didymus, were there together. Nathanael from Cana in Galilee and the sons of Zebedee were with them. So were two other disciples. 3 “I’m going out to fish,” Simon Peter told them. They said, “We’ll go with you.” So they went out and got into the boat. That night they didn’t catch anything. 4 Early in the morning, Jesus stood on the shore. But the disciples did not realize that it was Jesus. 5 He called out to them, “Friends, don’t you have any fish?” “No,” they answered. 6 He said, “Throw your net on the right side of the boat. There you will find some fish.” When they did, they could not pull the net into the boat. There were too many fish in it. 7 Then the disciple Jesus loved said to Simon Peter, “It is the Lord!” As soon as Peter heard that, he put his coat on. He had taken it off earlier. Then he jumped into the water. 8 The other disciples followed in the boat. They were towing the net full of fish. The shore was only about 100 yards away. 9 When they landed, they saw a fire of burning coals. There were fish on it. There was also some bread.

Tuesday April 16 John 21:10-14

10 Jesus said to them, “Bring some of the fish you have just caught.” 11 So Simon Peter climbed back into the boat. He dragged the net to shore. It was full of large fish. There were 153 of them. But even with that many fish the net was not torn. 12 Jesus said to them, “Come and have breakfast.” None of the disciples dared to ask him, “Who are you?” They knew it was the Lord. 13 Jesus came, took the bread and gave it to them. He did the same thing with the fish. 14 This was the third time Jesus appeared to his disciples after he was raised from the dead.

Wednesday April 17 John 21:15-16

15 When Jesus and the disciples had finished eating, Jesus spoke to Simon Peter. He asked, “Simon, son of John, do you love me more than these others do?”

“Yes, Lord,” he answered. “You know that I love you.”

Jesus said, “Feed my lambs.”

16 Again Jesus asked, “Simon, son of John, do you love me?”

He answered, “Yes, Lord. You know that I love you.”

Jesus said, “Take care of my sheep.”

Thursday April 18: John 21:17-19

17 The third time he said to him, “Simon son of John, do you love me?” Peter was hurt because Jesus asked him the third time, “Do you love me?” He said, “Lord, you know all things; you know that I love you.” Jesus said, “Feed my sheep. 18 Very truly I tell you, when you were younger you dressed yourself and went where you wanted; but when you are old you will stretch out your hands, and someone else will dress you and lead you where you do not want to go.” 19 Jesus said this to indicate the kind of death by which Peter would glorify God. Then he said to him, “Follow me!”

Friday April 19 : John 21:20-25

20 Peter turned around. He saw that the disciple Jesus loved was following them. He was the one who had leaned back against Jesus at the supper. He had said, “Lord, who is going to hand you over to your enemies?” 21 When Peter saw that disciple, he asked, “Lord, what will happen to him?” 22 Jesus answered, “Suppose I want him to remain alive until I return. What does that matter to you? You must follow me.” 23 Because of what Jesus said, a false report spread among the believers. The story was told that the disciple Jesus loved wouldn’t die. But Jesus did not say he would not die. He only said, “Suppose I want him to remain alive until I return. What does that matter to you?” 24 This is the disciple who is a witness about these things. He also wrote them down. We know that what he says is true. 25 Jesus also did many other things. What if every one of them were written down? I suppose that even the whole world would not have room for the books that would be written.

SEMANA DE RESURRECCIÓN 3: El Evangelio de Juan

Lunes 15 de abril Juan 21:1-9

21 Después de esto, Jesús se apareció de nuevo a sus discípulos. Fue junto al Mar de Galilea. Esto es lo que sucedió. 2 Simón Pedro y Tomás, que también se llamaba Dídimo, estaban allí juntos. Natanael, de Caná de Galilea, y los hijos de Zebedeo estaban con ellos. Lo mismo ocurrió con otros dos discípulos. 3 —Voy a salir a pescar —les dijo Simón Pedro—. Dijeron: "Iremos contigo". Así que salieron y se subieron a la barca. Esa noche no pescaron nada. 4 De madrugada, Jesús se paró en la orilla. Pero los discípulos no se dieron cuenta de que era Jesús. 5 Y les gritó: Amigos, ¿no tenéis pescado? Ellos respondieron: "No.6 Él dijo: "Echa tu red a la derecha de la barca. Allí encontrarás algunos peces". Cuando lo hicieron, no pudieron tirar de la red hacia el bote. Había demasiados peces en ella.7 Entonces el discípulo que Jesús amaba dijo a Simón Pedro: «¡Es el Señor!» Tan pronto como Pedro escuchó eso, se puso su abrigo. Se lo había quitado antes. Luego saltó al agua. 8 Los otros discípulos lo siguieron en la barca. Estaban remolcando la red llena de peces. La orilla estaba a solo unos 100 metros de distancia. 9 Cuando desembarcaron, vieron un fuego de brasas encendidas. Había peces en él. También había algo de pan.

Martes 16 de abril Juan 21:10-14

10 Jesús les dijo: —Traigan algunos de los peces que acaban de pescar. 11 Simón Pedro volvió a subir a la barca. Arrastró la red hasta la orilla. Estaba lleno de peces grandes. Eran 153. Pero incluso con esa cantidad de peces, la red no se rompió. 12 Jesús les dijo: —Venid a desayunar. Ninguno de los discípulos se atrevió a preguntarle: «¿Quién eres?» Sabían que era el Señor. 13 Jesús se acercó, tomó el pan y se lo dio. Hizo lo mismo con los peces. 14 Esta fue la tercera vez que Jesús se apareció a sus discípulos después de haber resucitado de entre los muertos.

Miércoles 17 de abril Juan 21:15-16

15 Cuando Jesús y los discípulos terminaron de comer, Jesús habló a Simón Pedro. Le preguntó: "Simón, hijo de Juan, ¿me amas más que a los demás?"

"Sí, Señor", respondió. "Sabes que te quiero".

Jesús dijo: "Apacienta mis corderos".

16 Jesús volvió a preguntar: —Simón, hijo de Juan, ¿me amas?

Él respondió: "Sí, Señor. Sabes que te quiero".

Jesús dijo: "Cuida de mis ovejas".

Jueves 18 de abril: Juan 21:17-19

17 La tercera vez le dijo: Simón, hijo de Juan, ¿me amas? Pedro se sintió herido porque Jesús le preguntó por tercera vez: "¿Me amas?" Él dijo: "Señor, tú sabes todas las cosas; sabes que te amo". Jesús dijo: "Apacienta mis ovejas. 18 De cierto, de cierto os digo, que cuando eras más joven te vestías e ibas a donde querías; pero cuando seas viejo extenderás tus manos, y otro te vestirá y te llevará a donde no quieras ir". 19 Jesús dijo esto para indicar la clase de muerte por la cual Pedro glorificaría a Dios. Entonces le dijo: «¡Sígueme!»

Viernes 19 de abril : Juan 21:20-25

20 Pedro se dio la vuelta. Vio que el discípulo que Jesús amaba lo seguía. Él era el que se había recostado contra Jesús en la cena. Él había dicho: "Señor, ¿quién te va a entregar a tus enemigos?" 21 Cuando Pedro vio a aquel discípulo, le preguntó: —Señor, ¿qué le sucederá? 22 Jesús le respondió: —Supongamos que quiero que viva hasta que yo vuelva. ¿Qué te importa eso? Debes seguirme". 23 A causa de lo que Jesús dijo, se difundió entre los creyentes una falsa noticia. Se contó la historia de que el discípulo que Jesús amaba no moriría. Pero Jesús no dijo que no moriría. Él solo dijo: "Supongamos que quiero que permanezca vivo hasta que yo regrese. ¿Qué te importa eso?" 24 Este es el discípulo que da testimonio de estas cosas. También los escribió. Sabemos que lo que dice es verdad. 25 Jesús también hizo muchas otras cosas. ¿Y si cada una de ellas estuviera escrita? Supongo que ni siquiera el mundo entero tendría espacio para los libros que se escribirían.
